Operation Brightside would like to remove the graffiti from your property at the address listed on the attached sheet. There is **NO CHARGE** to you for this service, but we do need your permission. Please sign the **RELEASE FORM** as soon as possible and return to Operation Brightside, 4646 Shenandoah Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63110 or fax to 772-7444.

The graffiti will be removed by Operation Brightside's Environmental Youth Corps sometime, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. It will not be necessary for you to be present, unless you choose to be.

Please note, if the graffiti is on an unpainted brick or concrete surface, the Operation Brightside crews will use a high-pressure water blaster to remove the graffiti. There may be some slight discoloration of the brick, but there should be little, if any, damage.

If the graffiti is on a painted surface, the Operation Brightside crews will match the paint color as close as possible, square off the area, and paint over the graffiti.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter. Remember, there is **NO CHARGE** to you for this service. Our goal is to improve city neighborhoods by eradicating graffiti as soon as possible.
